Location: Wielkopolska region, Poznań – Bralin

Local coordinating organization and web link: Stowarzyszenie „Jeden Świat”

Dates: two consecutive months (60 days) from the beginning of October till end of November

Host Organisation Description: Stowarzyszenie „Jeden Świat’ (One World Association) is the Polish branch of **Service Civil International**, is a non-governmental organisation, which promotes a culture of peace and mutual understanding by means of international voluntary projects for people of all ages and backgrounds, local initiatives and programmes of education. By "opening" one person to another we want to raise social awareness, break down barriers and prejudices and build world of mutual respect and understanding.

Volunteer tasks:

This time we invite volunteers to work with our local volunteers to raise the youth awareness on global education and peace. How? There will be four volunteers working with youth and children in the local community conducting workshops for them and create the public event during the Global Education Week (the third week of November). It means:



- first there will be training about Global Education and peace specific, preparation on how to run a workshop
- then running workshops on peace and global education in schools and kindergardens
- preparing and taking part in the Living library (with previous preparation with experts)
- running workshops in schools on the topic of the volunteers culture, country and language
- taking care of social media

- taking care of digital documentation of the workshops projects run by our Association
- participate and organise the raise awareness events, campaigns and other dissemination activities we create together in the educational group.

Places: 2-4

The most expected are Spanish and Irish but we are also open for other nationalities coming from Spain and Ireland.

You will stay in the EVS apartment near the office. The flat has got fully equipped kitchen, washing machine, internet connection, bed linen. Food equivalent as well as pocket money will be provided at the beginning of the month. The city transport card will be provided to volunteers to be used while needed.

Volunteers' support: Every volunteer will be supported by a mentor, the learning process will be also guided by the educational coordinator.

Volunteer profile: – 18-30 at time of application willing to dedicate his or her time to learn and share things with youngsters in our region, interested in working with non formal education tools on raising people's awareness.
